Pie Drop Off: Please drop your pie at Fonthill Castle (front desk area), East Court Street & Route 313, Doylestown, PA 18901 on July 3 between 11 am and 4 pm or on July 4 by 11 am.

All pies **MUST** be accompanied by a **3X5 card** with registrant name, recipe name, list of ingredients, list of all common food allergens (i.e. "This pie contains nuts, soy, etc.").

- Museum staff will have final say on acceptability of all pie entries.
- Pies will be judged on 75% taste and 25% overall appeal & presentation.
- Winners will be announced at 2 pm in the Fonthill tent. Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place.
- Pie contestants will receive one free entry into Fonthill's July 4th event.
- Winners with their winning pie recipes will appear on our organization's website.

Contest Rules

- All registrants must be 18 year or older.
- Professional bakers or those who earn a portion of their livelihood from baking or cooking may NOT enter the contest.
- One pie entry per person.
- All pies must be made by hand, including the crust. No store-bought pies.
- All pies must be in a 9-inch pie plate/pan.
- No pies requiring refrigeration (dairy-based, cream or meat).
- Non-edible materials are not permitted.
