Below are four objects that could be found on historic farms or used by farmers.

- A) **Sheep Shearing Tool:** Farmers used this tool to give sheep a “haircut.” The tool cut off the sheep’s wool to allow them to feel cooler in the warm summer months.

- B) **Corn Husking Tool:** Farmers used this tool to remove the outer husk of corn. The tool’s point pulled the husk off the ear of corn.

- C) **Reaping Hook:** Farmers used this tool to cut grain crops for harvest. All crops were cut by hand before being wrapped in bundles and moved from the field to the barn.
