## Winter Wonderland: Fonthill Castle Daily One-Hour Guided Tours

Daily from November 20 – January 3, 2021, except the first three weekends in December

Throughout the holiday season, <u>our daily one-hour guided historic house tours</u> of Fonthill Castle will showcase Henry Mercer's home decked out for the holidays while sharing the history of Mercer and the construction of this unbelievable property.



Fonthill Castle's interior features Mercer's renowned, handcrafted ceramic tiles designed at the height of the Arts and Crafts movement, and the castle serves as an early example of reinforced concrete architecture with forty-four rooms, two hundred windows and eighteen fireplaces.

Fonthill Castle is open seven days from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., and is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Please note: There are steep stairs and narrow, uneven passageways on this tour.

Tours will be limited to 5 guests and one guide per timed entry to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience. Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your start time. Late arrivals may not be accommodated.

### **About Fonthill Castle**

Located in Doylestown, Bucks County, PA, the Mercer Museum and Fonthill Castle are two historic castles celebrating the legacy of Henry Chapman Mercer (1856-1930), American archaeologist, anthropologist, ceramicist and scholar. Both sites are operated by the Bucks County Historical Society.

Fonthill Castle was built between 1908-1912 and was the home to Henry Chapman Mercer. Mercer built Fonthill Castle as his home and as a showplace for his collection of tiles and prints. The castle serves as an early example of reinforced concrete and features forty-four rooms, over two hundred windows, and eighteen fireplaces. Fonthill Castle's interior features Mercer's renowned, hand crafted ceramic tiles designed at the height of the Arts and Crafts movement.

Fonthill Castle is located at 525 East Court Street, Doylestown, PA. Guests can park in the designated parking lot located off of the main entrance on Swamp Road (Rt. 313).
